


Step by Step Guide – 1. How to sign up

Important: if you are the first person of your company to sign up, you will become the company admin and will need to accept or deny users in the future.

Once you onboard more colleagues to SiGREEN, we recommend having at least two company admins from your company.

- 1. Go to SiGreen platform: https://app.sigreen.siemens.com/
- 2. Click 'Sign up here'
- 3. Fill in and press 'Next'

There are 4 main user roles in SiGreen

Company Admin

- Manages the company users and permissions
- Manages
 manufacturing location
 s, business units
 available
- Adds certifiers to the account
- Will have access to the API access configuration

Procurement Manager

- Owns the relationship and communication with suppliers
- Manages and set up components and suppliers
- Has the view on component categories, procured components and adds secondary data
- Decides if primary or secondary data is used for the PCF
- Requests PCF for components

Product Manager

- Shares PCF of a product with company's customers
- Creates products and associated bill of material (BOM) or recipes
- Manages product carbon footprint for a product
- Has the product portfolio view
- Creates, reports

 and determines
 product

 PCF according to specific standards



- 2) Edit Company Information


Under Company Information the following **mandatory** fields need to be added:






To start the PCF request process, you first need to add, then invite your suppliers to SiGREEN.

⇒ Procurement Manager role controls this step.




To be able to request a PCF Credential. The suppliers need to be invited and have an active account on SiGREEN. There are two ways to request a PCF Credential.

⇒ Procurement Manager role controls this step.

























