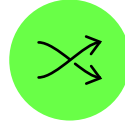
What is the TfS PCF Exchange Solution?

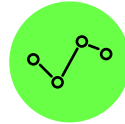
Secure data exchange

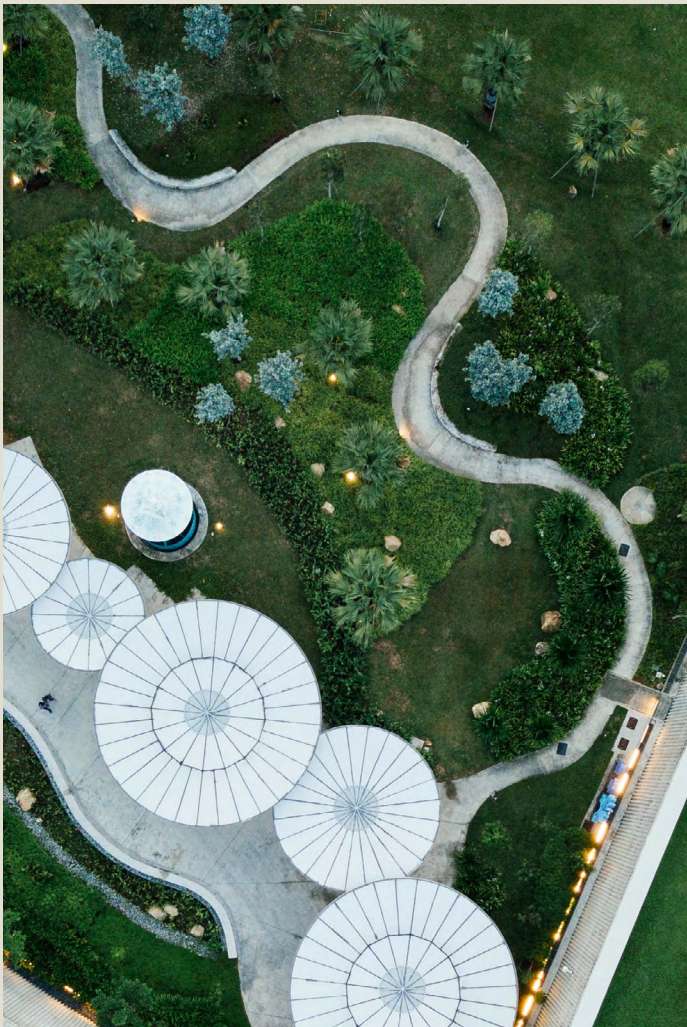
